Joe:

Upon looking at your weekly, I wanted to say you did an **AWESOME Job!**
Considering it was your first solo week...

You had some minor paperwork errors, and I'll give you a run down on what they were:

Your PI arrest on 6/7, You claimed .7 hours next to code 655 and 2.2 hours logged for 650. In the future show all time spent with suspect (start-finish) logged under code 650. You did a good job compensating the time and logging it under 610 and I let it go under that time this time. Don't forget to carry your 655 item code to the back of page 6 and also claim a 639 for the F.I. (I claimed these for you).

Your report on this was great (short and sweet as it should be on a PI arrest). It is not necessary and is redundant to complete a Navajo DPS report along with our Offense report. Be sure to make 1 copy for the court/prosecutor and 1 for DPS in the future.

On your bubble sheets, your handwriting looks great. You missed putting down a location on a warning you issued to subject Mckerry (465/US 160).

Nice variety...I loved the 28-935B warning (red flag on projected load) as well as the 28-3480 (corr. lens) violations. Good t-28 knowledge. However, 28-935b is a Repair order not a non-hazardous warning...no biggie.

Citation receipts: Go ahead and write in my name/badge/district and date of issue (the date you opened the book ie. 6/7/08).

Joe, I'm totally pleased with your paperwork (as I wipe away the tears of joy from my eye...) These issues above are totally minor and I mention them only to give you some feed back and make some adjustments.

Next week, I will meet with you and go over your 6 month evaluation. At that time, I will sit down with you and give you the expectations for Officer when it comes to evaluation, as well as some of my do's/don'ts. So far you are looking good, and I saw your red tags on 2 abandoned vehicles along us160 this am which means you are covering the area...Good! You had area coverage solo this past weekend and must have been okay since I didn't hear from you. Keep up the good work.

Have you received your Radar Certificate yet from CSP? Once I see a copy of this, you can start writing speeding cites off the radar. For now, stick with warnings, unless you get a pace, or stopwatch to justify the cite.

******OFFICIAL NOTICE******

It has come to my attention that Jude Nelson in Kayenta Justice Court is collecting fines and/or suspended drivers licenses for non-payment from tribal members cited by us into her court. This **WAS NOT** my initial intentions and am therefore Suspended this practice from any member of this squad.

DO NOT ISSUE state citations to tribal members into either the Chinle or Kayenta Justice courts.

When working in Kayenta (and I still expect to see coverage and activity in Kayenta) and you issue a citation a tribal member, utilize the Navajo Nation citations. These need to be followed up with a contact tracking form (DPS Warning/R.O.) as an "information only". When completing the bubble sheet, claim the full .1 hour of 209 time devoted to filling out that bubble sheet for that citation.

I also received notice from Window Rock prosecutor that they are not accepting our DPS citations either and sent back an entire stack of DPS tickets issued into their court citing the DPS tickets don't conform to their uniform tribal citation codes.

So I'm throwing up my hands and telling you all to comply with what each court wants. If they want the small tribal tickets, then that's what we will write for that court. I'm sure it is just a matter of time before all the courts get word from Window Rock to quit accepting our cites.

We get paid (extremely well, I might add) either way and if it causes us a little more paper work...Big deal, we can handle it. It is our jobs to issue citations and not get involved heavily in the politics of the matter.

So don't quit writing tickets out of spite or profile the non-indians. Fill out the necessary paperwork and rember, "It all counts to 20" anyway, so have fun and go home safe.

Thank you all for the hard work you do.

On your DVER's: Be sure to write in plain language the violation...not just 701a.
example: Local Laws/Speeding, 28-701A.

Other than that, and the issue we spoke about on Sunday reference putting truck inspection time under code 641 and not 610, everything looked really good. Thank you.

Joe:

I want you to look this weekly over again and use it as a reference of what MISTAKES not to keep making!

Sun, Wed: You show 10-7 (instead of 10-8) both days.
Thurs: You show 10-8 (instead of 10-7)

Sunday: From 0737 to 0857 you worked a crash, but didn't claim this time over to the appropriate code (#410-Accident investigation).

Sunday: From 12-1230...no entries after that.

Thurs: You claimed 410 time while assisting 347 with the DUI crash...Since you assisted what is the correct code?

209 time: 11.3 hours for the week. This is way too much time! You need to work on your efficiency and reduce this time. It shouldn't take 12 to 18 minutes to complete a TRACS after each stop... a .1 is the squad average. Be sure to claim the time spent reading email as 212 and not lumping this time in with 209 time, while at the office.
Remember also what I told you on Wednesday to only upload your TRACS once at the end of the week. Therefore there will not be an excess amount of office time at Red Mesa.

Look at these examples.

Saturday:
07-0746: **.8 (only .7)** doing weekly update/TRACS/10-17's.
09-1006: 1.1 of 209/212, (which was which?).

Sunday:
0904-1126: 2.4 209/212/411, (which time was which?)

Thursday:
0715-0733: .3, 209, weekly update (eat this as 300 time)
0913-1043: 1.5, 209, 10-17's (what 10-17's?)

No...You were the "Glitch" not the computer.

Cover page: You tried to show your overtttime as .75 hours. We don't claim time like this. It is .8 or .7.

The problem with the totaling was on Friday when you tried to show .3 hours of code 655 (on the arrest of Tso). Look at page 6, you can't claim hours when the hours collumn is shaded out. Should have just showed the entire time from 11-1230 under the time code of 650, and claimed items for everything else. I told you this prior to not break up stop time when an arrest is involved. Everytime you try to seperate your stop time from arrest time, you end up with problems having it total in the end. Like I told you a couple weeks ago, any time a traffic stop leads to an arrest, claim the start to finish under the arrest code (650) and just claim the item(s) for 610, 623, 655, etc.

Also when claiming items, make sure the code allows you to claim the "item". Code 224 does not allow you to transfer "items" to page 5 (take a look). This is Michelle's pet peeve. Again look out for the shaded areas. The shading means you can't claim either the time or the items.

Your 209 time was looking good and Low. Thanks...And thank you for cleaning up the Ky103. Good job.

Every Week, I am tasked with sending a weekly report to Sgt. Chase prior to 9:30 am. In this report, I am asked to type any significant events that may have occurred during the previous week. What I have been doing is reviewing your weeklies and finding things to place into this report...However some Monday's I'm pressed for time and pulling up each individual weekly and reviewing the contents takes away from this time.

So what I need each of you to start doing "EVERY WEEK" is when you email me your weekly...write up the most significant event that occurred to you during the week in your email that contains your weekly attachment.

It can be agency assist (such as the time Joe and Andy looking for the guy with the chainsaw that was threatening his family. Or helping by taking a call for the PD since they were short handed.) Serious Collision, unusual traffic stops, pursuits, unusual arrests, Public relations, problem that could impact DPS, etc.
