EYE SPY WEB EDITORIAL

FROM THE EDITOR - MARK BIRDSALL



From the publication of Eye Spy 97 to our latest magazine, the news media has reported on a plethora of incidents and stories relevant to the world of intelligence. Sadly, as readers began to digest the content of the last edition, a terrorist cell fronted by a lunatic drugged and brainwashed by the terror planners of ISIS, killed 38 people on the warm sands of the popular and historic resort of Sousse in Tunisia. Security was poor, some say non-existent, but events like this take little planning and can, I am convinced, occur just about anywhere. The gunman, Seifeddine Rezgui, had been to Libya and was trained by a rather nasty outfit. Rezgui had no exit strategy, he was a suicide operative. Whether or not he knew this as the cocktail of drugs in his system took hold remains a poignant question, but he chose to join ISIS and agreed to attack. In the corridors of Langley, and perhaps even on the banks of the River Thames at Vauxhall, such individuals are referred to as Manchurian Candidates.

A few weeks later, and thousands of miles away in Chattanooga, Tennessee, another ISIS inspired terrorist struck in the person of Muhammad Youssef Abdulazeez. Heavily armed, (evidence of his intent) and perhaps influenced by Rezgui and the Charlie Hebdo incident earlier this year in Paris, Abdulazeez attacked two US military facilities - a recruiting centre and a naval reserve base. The sites were soft targets and the gunman knew this. Five troopers died. What I found most interesting was President Obama did not refer to the incident as a terrorist case. If ever a case file should be described as such it was this one.

Both incidents are analysed in this edition, plus we take a look at the CIA's most secret programme which is targeting the world's leading terrorists - regardless of their allegiance.

Of much interest no doubt to readers of Eye Spy, the deal with Iran over its nuclear programme. Two decades of skulduggery, assassinations, cyber attacks, threats, sanctions, mischief and the odd inspection of its sites, an international committee and Iranian officials have agreed to a deal. Iran will no longer be able to enrich

uranium in the quantities and quality necessary for use in a nuclear bomb. In return, sanctions will be lifted. If ever a deal was controversial then it is this one. Within days of the agreement between the so-called P5+1 group and Iran, called the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action, Supreme Leader Ayatollah Khamenei tweeted a picture that shows President Obama committing suicide. It's clear which side believes it has got the best deal. More worryingly for the intelligence world, and especially Iran's neighbours, part of the agreement is flawed by caveats. IAEA inspectors thought they would be able to conduct impromptu visits to the nuclear sites and gain access to military bases linked to the programme. Iran has made it clear they will not. On 3 August 2015, Ali-Akbar Velayati, head of Iran's powerful Expediency Council Research Center confirmed Iran would not allow the IAEA to visit sites which the international community believe will become active.

"Iran will reserve all rights regarding its military centres," said Velayati. "Regardless of P5+1 countries interpretation, Iran has always clearly said it prohibits inspection of military bases by IAEA or any other institutions." And Iran may well be in its rights to make this stand - for those caveats are real and it is all about interpretation. We have world reaction and comments from those who for years were involved in the secret war with Iran to halt its progress to a bomb - including the Mossad.

And on the topic of this super secretive organisation, we have somewhat of an exclusive in respect of a covert Mossad operation enabled in London which eventually resulted in the assassination of Syrian President Assad's closest confidant.



Two tradecraft features on body language and intelligence analysis make fascinating reading, so too our view of a secret OSS, US Navy and then later CIA programme linked to sharks, cartoons and psychology.

Aside from the dark side of intelligence, there is plenty in Eye Spy 98 to keep the spy aficionados happy - including an alternative explanation to why MI6 and Naval Intelligence Division officer Ian Fleming, decided to call his famous agent James Bond!

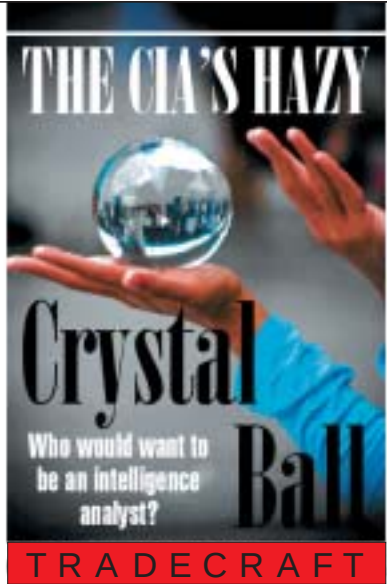

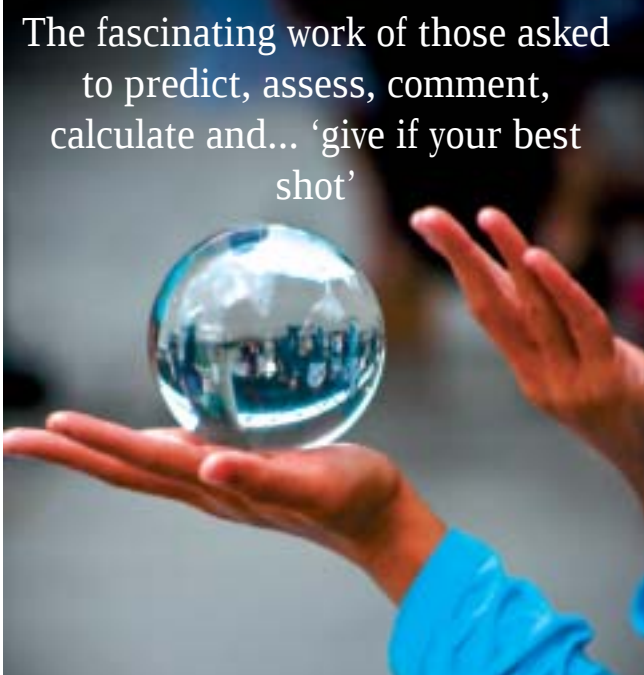

THE REVELATION

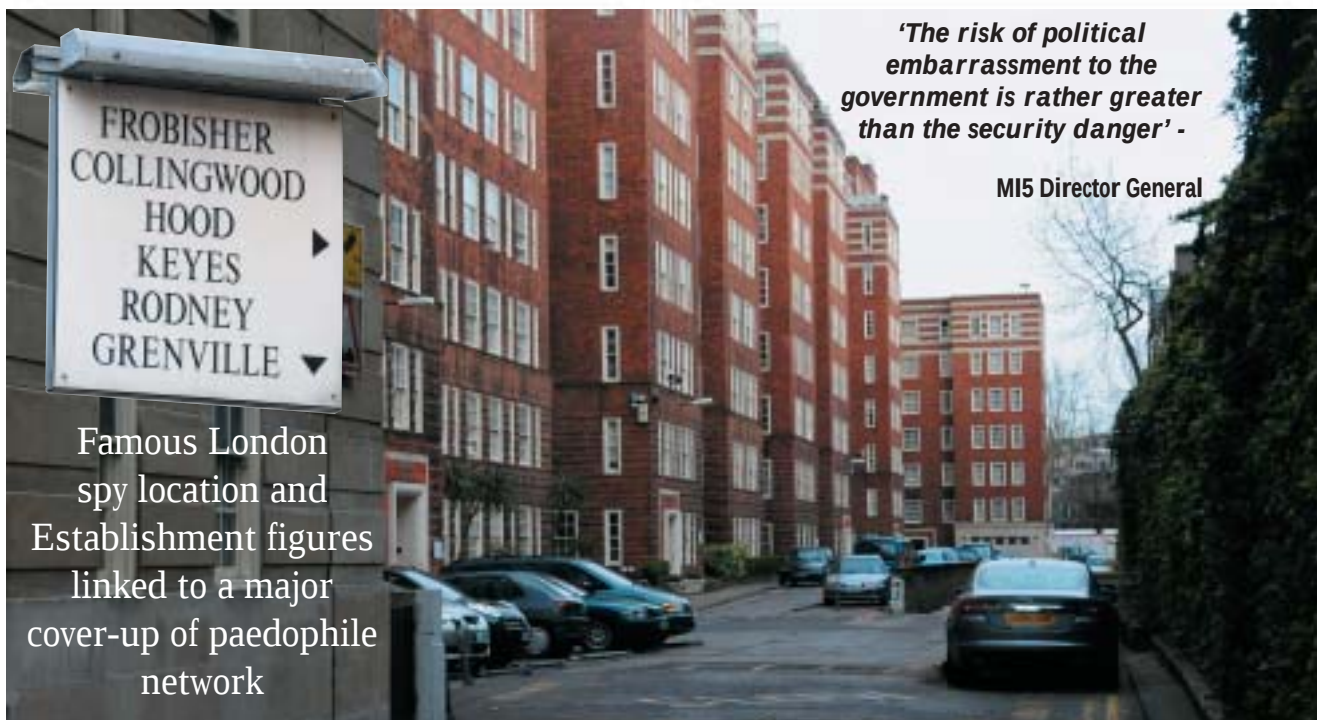
