US and Iraq

Try telling them that the occupation is now over

"Let freedom reign," wrote George Bush, but he's keeping a tight grip on Iraq and its wealth

"THE ENORMOUS oil wealth of Iraq is there for the Iraqi people, which is why we have said it should go in a trust fund for the Iraqi people-not for America, not for Britain, not for any outside power-but for the Iraqi people." That was the promise given by Tony Blair in an interview with Abu Dhabi Television in April last year.

Two months earlier Ari Fleischer, White House press secretary, said, "Iraq, unlike Afghanistan, is a rather wealthy country. Iraq has tremendous resources that belong to the Iraqi people. "And so there are a variety of means that Iraq has to shoulder much of the burden for their own reconstruction." But now a very different picture is emerging.

Billions of dollars of Iraqi oil revenue have vanished and billions were spent in a last-minute spree before the Coalition Provisional Authority (CPA) was dissolved in the fake "handover" of power to the interim government. The charity Christian Aid has revealed that the audit into the CPA's use of Iraqi oil revenue will be suppressed until mid-July. No one from the CPA will ever be held to account.

The Christian Aid report, "Fuelling Suspicion: The Coalition and Iraq's Oil Billions", estimates that up to \$20 billion in oil revenues is unaccounted for. Some of the money has gone into the Development Fund for Iraq, which is run by ten foreigners and one Iraqi appointed by Paul Bremer. The CPA plundered over \$2 billion from this fund in the run-up to the "handover" to fund "reconstruction projects", rather than use funds that the US government promised.

The CPA refused to reveal which companies are benefiting from this robbery, but most reconstruction is being carried out by US-based multinationals, many of which have close links to the Bush cabinet. US companies are charging up to ten times more than Iraqi companies for reconstruction work.

The new Iraqi government will be obliged to honour these contracts. And, according to Svetlana Tsalik, Iraq Revenue Watch's director, "With so much money available for cash give-aways, and so little planning on how the process will work, it will be all but

impossible to avoid corruption and waste."

Over \$600 million in oil revenues have been handed over to the Kuwaiti government—a royal dictatorship which presides over one of the wealthiest Middle Eastern states—in compensation for the 1991 invasion.

It is not clear how much money has been made from oil sales. Two different CPA documents give figures that differ by \$1.5 billion. Christian Aid believes that the CPA's figures might underestimate the amount made by as much as \$3 billion.

The US stooges who've been imposed on the Iraqi people

Ayad Allawi

The new prime minister of Iraq was chosen by the Iraqi Governing Council—an appointed body—at the urging of US administrator Paul Bremer. Allawi was born into a wealthy family and joined the ruling Ba'ath Party at an early age. He remained a member until 1976, when he fell out with Saddam Hussein.

While in exile in Britain he formed a close relationship with MI6 and later the CIA. In 1979 he started organising ex-Ba'athist generals into the Iraqi National Accord (INA). After the 1991 invasion of Kuwait, when Saddam Hussein fell out with Washington and London, money began pouring into the INA. In return Allawi fed the spooks on both sides of the Atlantic with information about the regime.

This information included the infamous claim that Saddam Hussein could launch weapons of mass destruction within 45 minutes, which was used in the case for war. He returned to Iraq as US troops captured Baghdad and argued against the disbanding of the Iraqi army. It is likely that he will restore many of the former generals who served under Saddam Hussein in an attempt to stamp out the resistance in Iraq.

According to the Economist magazine, "In recent months he has also been busy creating a new version of the secret police... Mr Allawi's rivals have accused him of recruiting former torturers for a new apparatus of oppression." A survey carried out by the Iraqi Centre for Research and Studies found he was the least popular of 17 prominent Iraqi political personalities. Nearly 40 percent of Iraqis polled were "strongly opposed" to Allawi.

Falah al-Nakib

THE NEW minister of the interior was born into a family with close ties to the Iraqi military. He trained in the US as a civil engineer. He recently threatened to impose martial law across Iraq to restore order, saying, "If we need to do it, yes, we'll do it. We won't hesitate."

Hazem Shaalan

THE DEFENCE minister was a manager of the Iraqi Real Estate Bank before falling out with Saddam Hussein. He also favours using strong-arm tactics to bring order to Iraq. He says, "A decision to impose martial law could be taken if the attacks continue."

After one bomb attack by resistance fighters he told reporters, "We will cut off the hands of those people. We will slit their throats if it is necessary to do so."

The US troops are staying

THE FAKE "handover" of power has done nothing to abate the fury of the overwhelming majority of Iraqis who oppose the occupation. More than 100 Iraqis have died in the past week as violence continues to grow across the country. In a sign of the increasing sophistication of the resistance fighters, a US transport plane was forced to return to Baghdad airport after being hit by gunfire.

Iraqi fighters have already partially cut the airport off from Baghdad, closing the main road for most of the day. Last week they organised coordinated attacks on police stations across central Iraq killing dozens of Iraqis. The US now hopes to see Iraqi security forces do much of the fighting and dying in Iraq. But the US government has no intention of removing its troops from Iraq.

They have created a huge fortified embassy in the heart of Baghdad, known as the "Green Zone", effectively a military base. The hundreds of staff at the new embassy, which will be the biggest ever created, will hide behind two metre high blast barriers.

Laws US left behind

AS WELL as continuing to dominate Iraq's economy, and leaving around 140,000 troops, the US has placed strict curbs on the interim government. Paul Bremer has rushed through 97 new laws, described as "binding instructions or directives to the Iraqi people", to control the new administration.

The most controversial gives a seven-member commission the power to disqualify political parties and any of the candidates they support from any elections in Iraq.

Other laws cap tax rates at 15 percent and prohibit piracy of intellectual property. The laws also include an order that car horns should only be used in "emergency conditions only" and another instructing drivers to "hold the steering wheel with both hands".

American torture

The torture carried out at Abu Ghraib jail was called "un-American" by George Bush and company. The beatings, fear, sexual humiliations, and deaths have been laid at the door of a few rogue elements and a breakdown in discipline.

However, we should nail this lie that torture is an aberration carried out by a few bad men and women. The US security forces and military have pursued torture as a policy since at least the 1960s and have actively trained other states in its use.

In July 1963, the CIA produced the Kubark manual, which outlines how to use coercive and non-coercive methods to break a prisoner. It includes advice such as that, when choosing a room, "the electric current should be known in advance, so that transformers and other modifying devices will be on hand if needed."

Chapter 9 lists the main methods of coercive interrogation: arrest, detention, sensory deprivation, isolation, pain and fear. Fear is a key weapon: "The threat of coercion usually weakens or destroys resistance more effectively than coercion itself. The threat to inflict pain, for example, can trigger fears more damaging than the immediate sensation of pain." Methods include detention "in a cell which has no light"; "an environment still more subject to control, such as water-tank or iron lung, is even more effective."

Also in the 1960s, the US army produced several manuals through its Project X, which drew on its experience in Vietnam, and was used mainly with US allies in South America.

The CIA's secret Human Resource Exploitation Training Manual (1983) drew on Kubark and

the Project X manuals, creating an even more developed torture manual.

The CIA trained the Honduran military in the 1980s. The abuses of the Hondurans led to a US House of Senate investigation in 1988. As a result of the investigation, the phrase "While we do not stress the use of coercive techniques, we do want to make you aware of them" was changed to "while we deplore the use of coercive techniques, we do want to make you aware of them so that you may avoid them." Obviously they don't deplore them enough.

Throughout the 1980s, when Ronald Reagan was president, Project X distributed more than 1,000 copies of these manuals for use in countries such as El Salvador, Guatemala, Ecuador and Peru, and used it at the School of the Americas (a US military training school in Georgia) between 1987 and 1991.

Human rights abuses were carried out by people trained in these torture methods including, in November 1989, the massacre of six Jesuit priests, their co-worker and her teenage daughter in El Salvador. A US Congressional Task Force reported that those responsible were trained by the US Army. This prompted, in March 1992, the then Secretary of Defence Richard Cheney (now vice president) to investigate their use. The report found that five of the seven manuals it looked at "contained language and statements in violation of legal, regulatory or policy prohibitions" and recommended they be recalled. The report was stamped: "SECDEF [Cheney] HAS SEEN." So Cheney was aware that the US was carrying out illegal interrogations back then. He ordered "corrective action" and the destruction of manuals.

However, far from being "an innocent", Cheney's complicity in these manuals came to light in 1991 when Major Victor Tise, who helped run the training, was recorded on the telephone giving a history of the project's work with Latin American torturers. Tise said that the manuals had been forwarded to the Department of Defense (Cheney's fiefdom) for clearance "and came back approved but unchanged".

There are regular demonstrations at the School of the Americas calling for the closure of the camp or for the teaching of torture to stop. The demonstrations may succeed. But torture is not just carried out by ill-disciplined raw recruits. When the US and UK fight imperialist wars one of the weapons they will use is torture, just as it has been used in Vietnam, Ireland and now Iraq.

The June 1947 issue of The Bulletin of the Atomic Scientists featured, for the first time, a large clock on its cover. A permanent fixture thereafter, the clock was borne out of nuclear testing in the South Pacific, the impending arms race between the U.S. and the Soviet Union and the unknown dangers of radiation. The "Doomsday Clock" represented, in the words of an accompanying editorial, "the state of mind of those whose closeness to the development of atomic energy does not permit them to forget that their lives and those of their children, the security of their country and the survival of civilization, all hang in the balance as long as the specter of atomic war has not been exorcized."

The hands of the clock were last moved on February 27, 2002. With little progress on nuclear disarmament, nuclear tests by India and Pakistan and concerns about the security of nuclear weapons materials, the minute hands of the clock were moved from nine to seven minutes to midnight. Now the spectre of nuclear weapons rises again over a recalcitrant North Korea and as part of the reason to force "regime change" in Iraq.

On Oct. 7, 2002 George W. Bush said, "The evidence indicates that Iraq is reconstituting its nuclear weapons program. Saddam Hussein has held numerous meetings with Iraqi nuclear scientists, a group he calls his 'nuclear mujahideen' -- his nuclear holy warriors. Satellite photographs reveal that Iraq is rebuilding facilities at sites that have been part of its nuclear program in the past." He raised the same point in these now-infamous sixteen words from his State of the Union address: "The British government has learned that Saddam Hussein recently sought significant quantities of uranium from Africa." The claim was revealed to be based on forged evidence and was convincingly debunked by former Ambassador Joseph Wilson, in his New York Times article "What I Didn't Find in Africa."

Despite this finger-pointing, the current threat from nuclear weapons and their inherent danger comes not from Iraq or North Korea but the United States and its allies. Scientists all over the world are amassing ample proof that the use of depleted uranium weapons has poisoned thousands of U.S. soldiers, caused birth defects in Iraq to multiply at an alarming rate and made areas of Afghanistan radioactive and uninhabitable. Former U.S. Army medical personnel are among the most unrelenting critics of the use of DU weapons.

The number of countries with depleted uranium continues to grow. At least 17 countries already have in their arsenals bullets made from depleted uranium (DU). Many - such as Israel, Turkey, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait and Taiwan - get them from the United

States. England and France buy DU wholesale from the US. Russia now sells DU rounds on the open market.

In addition to the damage already done, the U.S. recently announced that it is seeking to introduce "low-yield" nuclear weapons into future conflicts. Unless the documentation of hundreds of doctors, scientists and researchers around the world is proven completely wrong, the U.S. has already brought the power and the fallout of nuclear weapons to the battlefield.

Natural uranium, as found in the earth's crust, is largely a mixture of two isotopes: uranium-238 (U-238), accounting for 99.3% and U-235 about 0.7%. A process to enrich U-238 creates uranium-235 for weapons and power plants. This procedure leaves behind a by-product called "depleted uranium," that is about 65% as radioactive as naturally occurring U-238.

In addition to its radioactivity, depleted uranium is highly toxic, especially if ingested. Thousands of tons of the material was produced as a byproduct of producing thousands of nuclear weapons, creating a source of relatively inexpensive and effective armor-piercing projectiles. Depleted uranium is twice as dense as steel and pyrophoric in nature (it ignites on penetration). For these properties, DU was chosen over tungsten for use as both a defensive and offensive weapon.

However, when a DU weapon makes contact with a solid object and burns, the radioactive U-238 aerosolizes and is emitted into the environment in tiny particles. These U-238 particulates can be transported by wind or water and have been known to travel over 26 miles from their source. The toxic material enters the body through inhalation, ingestion, exploded fragments or other wound contamination.

In the U.S., depleted uranium weapons are handled by workers in HAZMAT suits and regular environmental testing is conducted in the areas where it is produced and test-firing is conducted. The Aberdeen Proving Ground (also known as the Superbox) where DU weapons are test-fired, consists of a 100 lb TNT blast equivalency containment vessel, real-time air quality monitoring and a highspeed door which closes immediately after the munitions pass through it to further minimize the amount of DU released to the open air. In Kosovo and Iraq, U.S. soldiers are exposed to the material with no protection, children play on radioactive tanks destroyed by DU weapons and depleted uranium shells litter the countryside.

U.S. and Allied forces fired approximately 350 tons of depleted uranium during the first Gulf War. During the second Gulf War, researchers estimate as many as 2,000 tons of depleted uranium was used. Ground forces, crews of military equipment who fired DU, Allied forces involved in "friendly fire" incidents, and soldiers who were around DU strike points were all exposed to the material.

Scott Peterson of the Christian Science Monitor recently travelled to Iraq to measure radiation levels caused by DU weapons. The Monitor visited four sites in the city, including two randomly chosen Iraqi armored vehicles, burned American ammunition trucks and the downtown planning ministry, and found widespread radioactive contamination.

One pile of dust yielded a readout of 9,839 radioactive emissions in one minute, more than 300 times average background levels. Another pile of dust reached 11,585 emissions in a minute. Peterson also reported that six American vehicles struck with DU "friendly fire" in 1991 were deemed to be too contaminated to take home, and were buried

in Saudi Arabia.

A DU tank round recovered in Saudi Arabia in 1991 was found by a US Army radiological team to be emitting 260 to 270 millirads of radiation per hour. The current U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission limit for non-radiation workers is 100 millirads per year. The normal public dose limit in the US, and recognized around much of the world, is 100 millirems per year. Of 16 vehicles brought back to a facility in South Carolina, six had to be buried in a low-level radioactive waste dump.

Peterson's investigation is a small contribution to the long-standing work of Dr. Doug Rokke. During the first Gulf War, the U.S. Army asked Major Rokke, a Vietnam veteran with over twenty years of service, to work with the U.S. Army Preventive Medicine Command and help prepare troops for nuclear, biological or chemical exposures. Dr. Rokke was in charge of cleaning up American tanks hit by DU during the first Gulf War, casualties of "friendly fire."

In numerous lectures and speeches he has repeatedly described his first reaction upon arriving in Iraq in three words: "Oh my God." According to Rokke, about 70% of DU rounds vaporize into dust as fine as talcum powder.

The dust from DU weapons exists in respirable sized particles, approximately 10 micrometers and less in diameter. It enters directly into lymph and blood through the lung-blood barrier and circulated throughout the whole body. These particles stay in the lungs for upwards of two years.

When his team climbed into vehicles that had been hit with DU weapons, the air was thick with DU dust. The team was given no protective gear during their mission. A 1995 physical exam by the US Department of Energy revealed that Rokke had 5,000 times the permissible level of uranium in his body.

Twenty of Rokke's team of ninety-one researchers are now dead and Rokke is seriously ill, he suffers reactive airway disease, neurological damage and kidney problems and now travels around the world, delivering powerful lectures on the dangers of depleted uranium.

Dr. Asaf Durakovic, a former Colonel in the U.S. Army has reached similar conclusions as Rokke. Dr. Durakovic was a professor of nuclear medicine at Georgetown University and the former head of nuclear medicine at the US Army's veterans' affairs medical facility in Delaware.

Dr. Durakovic was the first person to identify uranium poisoning in Gulf War veterans. Dr. Durakovic has also given several interviews to alert people to the dangers of depleted uranium.

He gave an interview to Democracy NOW! earlier this year when he described areas of Afghanistan as so irradiated, they would be uninhabitable for the "foreseeable future." Durakovic's research shows uranium levels of a much higher concentration than Gulf War veterans. He believes that it was non-depleted uranium that was used in Afghanistan. Tests taken from Jalalabad subjects showed concentrations 400% to 2000% above that for normal populations, amounts which have not been recorded in civilian studies before. One conclusion is that the allied forces are now possibly using milled uranium ore in their warheads to maximize the effectiveness and strength of their weapons.

Rokke and Durakovic, both with distinguished service records, are particularly concerned about the effects of depleted uranium on American soldiers. In September 2000,

Dr. Durakovic told a conference of nuclear scientists in Paris that "tens of thousands" of British and American soldiers are dying from radiation and soil samples from Iraq show radiation levels more than 17 times the acceptable level.

As of May 2002, 206,861 veterans had filed claims for benefits based on service-connected injuries and illnesses caused by Gulf War combat-related duties. The Department of Veterans Affairs has processed 183,249 claims for medical care, compensation, and pension, determining that for 159,238 veterans, their injuries and illnesses are service connected, caused by Gulf War exposures and injuries. Consequently they have been awarded lifetime medical care, compensation, and pensions based on the extent of their medical problems.

Since the cessation of Gulf War hostilities in 1991, an additional 8,013 veterans have died from service connected injuries and exposures incurred during operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm.

As of May 2002, the Gulf War casualties include 8,306 veterans dead and 159,705 veterans injured or ill as a consequence of wartime service. The official May 2002 Department of Veteran Affairs report classifies 16,8011 individuals as "disabled veterans," an astounding casualty rate of 29.3% for combat-related duties between 1990 and 1991. The VA still has claims from 23,612 individuals pending and has denied benefits to 24,011 veterans.

The danger from radiation is not restricted to the battlefield. The Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant outside Paducah, Kentucky, is a uranium enrichment facility owned by the U.S. Department of Energy. The plant employs about 1,400 people and produces low-enriched uranium fuel for commercial nuclear power plants. Toxins that were emitted into the air, spilled into streams and ground water, and buried are moving through the food chain.

An investigation by the Louisville-Courier-Journal showed that many of the more than 6,000 people who have worked at the plant are sick; most blame the radiation and toxic chemicals in the factory. They said they had inadequate protection from the ubiquitous dust and were not told of the danger. Similar claims are made by citizens living near the Oak Ridge facility and the dangers of uranium mining are well-documented.

Dr. Rokke's and Dr. Durakovic's claims are echoed by hundreds of individuals and organizations alike, from the Royal Society in Britain to former Attorney General Ramsey Clark. Researcher Dai Williams has conducted an astonishing amount of research into depleted uranium weapons and several documentaries including Iraq: Paying the Price by John Pilger and Downwind by Pinhole Pictures, both explore the damage caused by these weapons.

The Nuclear Policy Research Institute (founded by Helen Caldicott) has been established to educate the world about the "medical, environmental, political and moral consequences of perpetuating nuclear weapons, power and waste." The NPRI held its first scientific symposium on June 14, 2003 and all of the presentations and research from that symposium are available to the public.

Scientific consensus is that depleted uranium weapons must be banned, individuals who may have been exposed to depleted uranium must receive medical care and all depleted uranium fragments and contaminated equipment must be cleaned up and disposed of at secure sites. Although the U.K. government has committed itself to begin testing its soldiers for uranium poisoning, the U.S. refuses to conduct similar testing and has ruled out the

clean up of areas where DU was used.

Unless these recommendations from the scientific community are adopted, it seems certain that more soldiers will die and more countries where DU weapons are used will become radioactive and uninhabitable. The dangers of DU weapons must be addressed soon. The clock is ticking.

message = LOS ANGELES, California (CNN) -- A police officer pursuing the driver of a stolen car Wednesday morning was seen on videotape beating the suspect after he appeared to have surrendered.

Officers from the Los Angeles Police Department began chasing the stolen car shortly after 5 a.m. (8 a.m. ET).

The pursuit ended in the city of Compton, when the driver jumped out of the vehicle and fled on foot.

Video shot from news helicopters shows the suspect running for a short distance before slowing to a stop, apparently opting to surrender to officers pursuing him on foot.

The suspect appeared to raise both arms and drop to his knees. The first arriving officer drew his weapon, but put it back in his holster and then tackled the suspect, forcing him to the ground.

The second officer also jumps on the suspect, who is on the ground in a prone position, while a third officer arrives and appears to kick him in the head. This same officer then drops to the ground, takes out his flashlight and beats the suspect 11 times about the head area and also appears to use his knee to strike the suspect.

Detainees held in Afghanistan by American troops have been routinely tortured and humiliated as part of the interrogation process, in the same way as those in Iraq, a Guardian investigation has found.

Five detainees have died in custody, three of them in suspicious circumstances, and survivors have told stories of beatings, stripings, hoodings and sleep deprivation.

Still behind bars, despite DNA evidence

If you think the mission of our justice system is to seek out the truth, try telling that to Wilton Dedge. He has spent the last 22 years, more than half his life, locked in prison. The great state of Florida wants to keep him there, despite the strongest scientific evidence that Dedge didn't commit the rape for which he was convicted.

For three years, prosecutors have known about a DNA test that pointed toward a different assailant, yet they have vigorously opposed any efforts to free Dedge or get him a new trial.

Just last month, an assistant attorney general told incredulous appellate judges that Dedge's guilt or innocence was irrelevant. The issue, she said, was the timing -- not the outcome -- of the DNA test.

In 1982, Dedge was charged with raping a 17-year-old girl at knifepoint in Brevard County.

The case had problems from the beginning. Initially the victim described her attacker as six feet tall, muscular, weighing 200 pounds and going bald. Dedge was barely five foot six, weighed 125 to 130 pounds and had a full head of hair. The victim picked him from a photograph supplied by police.

As a juvenile Dedge had once been charged with burglary, but as an adult he had never been arrested for anything. Six of his co-workers at an auto shop testified that he was there during the time when the rape occurred.

The key physical evidence was two pubic hairs recovered from the victim's bed. An expert from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement told the jury that the hairs were "microscopically identical" to Dedge's.

In his summation, prosecutor Wayne Holmes said the hairs proved that only Wilton Dedge could be the rapist. Jurors voted to convict.

Later, a retrial was ordered. Dedge was convicted again after prosecutors produced a prison informant who said that Dedge had privately admitted committing the rape. (In return for his testimony, the informant got 120 years sliced off his own sentence.)

Years later, as DNA screening emerged as a forensic tool, Dedge sought to have the pubic hairs from the crime scene tested and the genetics matched against his own.

For a decade he tried, and for a decade prosecutors fought his efforts. During that time Dedge's case was taken up by the Innocence Project and its co-founder, Barry Scheck. A member of O.J. Simpson's "dream team," Scheck specializes in DNA forensics.

In late 2000, Dedge finally got his test. The results were definitive: The pubic hairs from the rape victim's bed did not belong to Dedge.

A different person had been at the crime scene. But, astoundingly, prosecutors said it didn't matter that their most critical piece of evidence had been discredited.

They said that because Dedge had gotten his DNA processed before the state's DNA rules were passed, the findings weren't admissible.

Somehow the technicality became more important than the truth. In a perverse Catch-22, Dedge was being penalized for clearing himself too soon.

"Premature vindication," in the caustic words of Milton Hirsch, the Miami defense lawyer who is presenting Dedge pro bono.

Ironically, had Dedge's DNA been tested a few months later -- after the Legislature set the guidelines for such cases -- he would likely be free today.

Prosecutor Holmes wasn't budging. That the pubic hairs didn't belong to Dedge was of "little significance," Holmes claimed, given the eyewitness identification.

It was quite a different tune than he had sung at trial, when he'd declared that the hairs positively pegged Dedge as the rapist.

Finally, in June 2003, Brevard Circuit Judge J. Preston Silvernail ruled that Dedge's DNA results were admissible, and that he was entitled to seek a new trial.

Silvernail concluded "there is a reasonable probability that the Defendant would have been acquitted" if the DNA report had been available when he was first prosecuted.

Holmes has still refused to back off. He seems unbothered by the likelihood that he's keeping an innocent man in prison, or that the real rapist is still on the loose.

When prosecutors appealed Judge Silvernail's ruling, they got slapped in the chops.

"Why hasn't this guy been given a new trial? Why is the state standing in the way?" demanded Judge David Monaco of the 5th District Court of Appeal.

Assistant attorney general Bonnie Jean Parrish was there to argue that Dedge should remain in prison.

He failed to follow the rules in filing for his DNA test, she explained with a straight face, because the rules had not yet been adopted by the Legislature.

"Let me ask you a hypothetical question," said Judge Emerson Thompson. "If you knew with 100 percent certainty that this man was absolutely innocent, would that change your position in this case?"

"No," Parrish said. "That is not the issue."

There you have it. A man's innocence is not the issue. Twenty-two years of his life are gone, wasted, stolen -- and the state says it's not relevant. Not surprisingly, that unconscionable argument was slam-dunked by the appeals court on April 27. Prosecutors have got 30 days to seek a rehearing.

In the meantime, perhaps Attorney General Charlie Crist can explain why his office is still battling to keep Wilton Dedge behind bars -- three years after a DNA test shattered the state's case against him.

Crist could put an end to this long ordeal by reminding prosecutor Holmes that his paramount duty is to the cause of justice, which is only disgraced by miscarriages like this.

message = Jews in America are often spoken of as a 社minority. So they are, in more than a numerical sense, as I will explain. But despite their small numbers they are also a powerful faction, though the term faction is rarely applied to them.

In Federalist Number 10, James Madison gave a famous and useful definition of the word: 釘 a faction I understand a number of citizens, whether amounting to a majority or a minority of the whole, who are united and actuated by some common impulse of passion, or of interest, adverse to the rights of other citizens, or to the permanent and aggregate interests of the community.

The organized Jewish faction is what I call the Tribe. It 痴 a bit more specific than 鍍he Jews ; but it includes most Jews, who, as many opinion polls show, overwhelmingly support the state of Israel and, furthermore, overwhelmingly favor 菟regressive causes like legal abortion, 都sexual freedom, and 堵gay rights.

What is striking about the Tribe is not that its positions on such matters are necessarily wrong, but that they are anti-Christian. They are even anti-Judaic, in that they contravene the moral code of Moses. Jews today define themselves formally by descent (or, less politely, race, though the term is taboo) rather than by religion; and, less formally, by antagonism to Christianity. It would be inaccurate to say that the Tribe adopts certain social attitudes and political positions even though these are repugnant to most Christians. It adopts them chiefly because they are repugnant to Christians.

Within the Tribe, one of the worst sins a Jew can commit is to become a Christian, as witness Jewish hostility to Jews for Jesus. An irreligious or atheist Jew may claim Israeli citizenship at any time, but a Jew who has converted to Christianity may not. This antagonism is so predominant that the Tribe opposes not only government endorsements of Christianity, but even the public exaltation of the Old Testament (as in displays of the Ten Commandments on public property) because Christians have adopted it too. The 笛 udao-Christian tradition is a sentimental myth, treasured by many Christians but by very few Jews.

The Tribe has no pope or authoritative body defining its creed, but its attitudes aren 稚 hard to discern. As Samuel Johnson says, a community must be judged non numero sed pondere not by numbers, but by weight. And the preponderance of Jewish sentiment is clear: it loathes Christianity and Christian influence in public life. It resents Christian proselytizing, one of the first Christian duties (virtually banned in Israel). It considers the Gospels the very source of what it calls anti-Semitism. In fact, the very word anti-Semitism is basically a Tribal synonym for Christianity.

s. That is a challenge at any time; but it is a challenge that is not made easier when the debate becomes so heavily polarised, so polemical. The best legacy that Bobby Fischer could give to the world would be the fact that FR Chess was able to revolutionise the game of Chess. This requires rational persuasion, and it requires bringing people together to agree the way forward, no? Many of Bobby Fischer's opinions are very perceptive and very close-to-the-mark, and if there really is some kind of Judgement Day in the future, those opinions might be validated. But we are here in the real world, and the way to change the world (including the Chess World) is by taking a step at a time - then consolidating the position, and subsequently moving forward. We are faced with an even more difficult task when the real issues get clouded out by inflammatory language, and by giving the objects of Bobby Fischer's discontent all the ammunition they need to dismiss him as some kind of crank.

I listen to Bobby Fischer interviews and I hear a very sane person; but I hear also someone who is very frustrated, and I hear that frustration boiling over into extreme anger. Anger of this kind shows that there are deeply felt beliefs there, and also shows that there is a feeling of fatalism about the hopelessness of the situation. I ask one more time: what can be done? Surely rationalism, taking one step at a time and consolidating is the way forward. Millions of people around the world should be discovering FR Chess, and at the highest levels of the game top players (at least the ones with a true passion for the beauty of the game) should be moving over to FR Chess. That will only happen when the field is cleared of vitriole and bile. That will happen only when the atmosphere is cool and calm enough so that the facts, and not the opinions are what people focus on when considering the issue of FR Chess. I'd like Bobby Fischer to consider this: he has a good brain; he has m

ch to offer the world of Chess and perhaps the wider world also. If both Bobby Fischer and those who have angered him get to read this, then I ask for the final time that they combine their intellects to positive effect and produce for themselves and the wider world an answer to the question: what can be done?

"Gen Taguba stated:

"Between October and December 2003, at the Abu Ghraib Confinement Facility, numerous incidents of sadistic, blatant, and wanton criminal abuses were inflicted on several detainees.

"This systemic and illegal abuse of detainees was intentionally perpetrated by several members of the military police guard force (372nd Military Police Company, 320th Military Police Battalion, 800th MP Brigade), in Tier 1-A of the Abu Ghraib Prison."

He described specific abuses, which he said were "amply supported" by statements by suspects, detainees and witnesses.

They included:

Detainees were threatened with a loaded pistol

Cold water was poured on naked prisoners

Inmates were beaten with a broom handle and chair

Male detainees were threatened with rape

A prisoner was sodomised with a chemical light

Detainees were forced into various sexual positions to be photographed

Naked inmates were arranged in a pile and then jumped on

Male detainees were forced to wear women's underwear

Male detainees were forced to masturbate while being photographed and videotaped

Military dogs were used to frighten and intimidate; in one case a detainee was bitten
According to reports, Gen Taguba identified two military intelligence officers - a colonel and lieutenant colonel - and two civilian contractors as key figures in the abuses.

There have been allegations that military intelligence officers encouraged soldiers to abuse prisoners to soften them up for interrogation."
